Patricia V. Besmen, 77 years of age, became Our Gift to God on Thursday, November 25, 2021 at UH-Portage Medical Center in Ravenna, Ohio. Pat was God's Gift to Us on April 9, 1944, at Grantsville, West Virginia, the daughter of the late Rev. James E. and Odell (Frederick) Wilson. A lifetime area resident, Pat was a 1963 graduate of Aurora High School, living in Streetsboro the past 56 years. A homemaker, she had many interests including gardening, sewing, baking, fishing, and collecting antique furniture. She and her sisters were well known as the "Singing Wilson Sisters."
