Kyle C. Reid, 87 years of age, passed away Tuesday August 31, 2021 at Aurora, Ohio. Mr. Reid was born in Itmann, West Virginia on September 9, 1933, the son of the late James H. and Mary J. (Baugh) Reid, and one of eight children. A resident of Hiram the past 49 years, he had been employed at Chrysler Twinsburg Stamping Plant where he retired after 23 years of service. Mr. Reid served his country with honor in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict. He was a gentleman of many talents, including making his own tools, farming, and will be remembered for his strong work ethic, and that he dug out himself the pond on the family property. His faith also was very important, and Mr. Reid looked forward to the Bible study group he shared with others on Thursday evening. A proud grandfather, his love for family and grandchildren was only equaled to that which they returned to him. On April 18, 1955, he married Patsy (Wills) Reid who survives at their home. Also surviving are his children, Greg (Lisa) Reid of Mantua, Wes (Wendi) Reid, and LaDonne O'Connell both of Hiram, and Michelle (Jimmie) Yeatts of Mantua; siblings Harry Reid, and Juanita Phillips, both of West Virginia; 15 grandchildren, and 13 great-grandchildren. Visitation will be Tuesday September 7, 2021, at the Green Family Funeral Home & Crematory Service, 4668 Pioneer Trail at the corner of St. Rt. 44, Mantua, Ohio 44255, from 11:00 A.M.-1:00 P.M., where his funeral service will then begin at 1:00 P.M. with Mr. Michael Maschek officiating.
