Howard E. Browning, 66 years of age, passed away Wednesday February 17, 2021 at his residence. Born in Madison, West Virginia on January 8, 1955, he was the son of Roscoe D. and Sue (Flannery) Browning. A resident of Palmyra since 1990, he formerly lived in Mantua, and was a 1973 graduate of Crestwood High School. Mr. Browning had been employed at Graphic Packaging in Solon, from where he then retired. He had served with honor in the U.S. Navy.
