Virginia M. "Ginger" Sheller, 86 years of age, became Our Gift to God on Sunday January 24, 2021. (Buzek) Lucas, Sr. A lifetime Garrettsville area resident, she had been a graduate of James A. Garfield High School, and a member of St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Garrettsville. Mrs. Sheller had been employed as a clerical assistant at James A. Garfield school district elementary school, along with various other positions within the school district until her retirement.
