Alejandro Francisco Castro, also known as Alex or Sondor passed away on July 29, 2020 at Seasons Nursing Home in Stow due to Colon Cancer. Alex was born February 19, 1963 in Ravenna, Ohio to Alejo Castro Sierra and Helen Demchak. He is survived by his sister Mary Helen Castro of Madison, Wisconsin and his godmother/cousin Johnna Dreher of Elk Grove, California. Alex resided in Portage County since birth. He suffered from Schizophrenia during his adult life.
