Kathleen Stapleton, 72 years of age, was Our Gift to God Thursday March 26, 2020. Kathleen was God's Gift to Us on December 31, 1947 in East Cleveland, Ohio the daughter of the late John and AnnMarie (Coffey) Getts. She was a 1965 graduate of Collinwood High School, following which she was employed as an administrative assistant at General Electric Nela Park for 37 years retiring in 2003.
