Gustave George Dasch, Jr., 63 years of age, passed away unexpectedly on Monday February 3, 2020 at Uh-Geauga Medical Center in Claridon Township, Ohio. Mr. Dasch was born in Cleveland, Ohio on December 2, 1956, the son of the late Gustave George and Julia (Szuhay) Dasch, Sr. A lifetime resident of Troy Township, he was a 1975 graduate of Berkshire High School. He was a proud member of Local 18 of Ohio Operating Engineers, and had been employed at Koski Construction in Ashtabula, and at Gibson-Stewart in Oakwood. Gus loved spending time with his family, especially his boys and grandchildren. He enjoyed fixing tractors and fixing anything mechanical. He was a NASCAR enthusiast and enjoyed classic rock music.
