Hubert A. "John" Taylor, 89 years of age, passed away Wednesday June 26, 2019 in Rockledge, Florida. John was born in Cleveland, Ohio on January 12, 1930, the son of the late George and Thelma (Pincombe) Lourie. A lifetime Mantua resident, he was a member of the 1948 graduating class from Mantua High School.
