## O bituary GARRETTSVILLE

Robert J. Farley, 92 years of age, passed away Saturday April 20, 2019. Born in Freedom Township, Ohio on April 3, 1927, he was the son of the late Ray and Bessie M. (Davis) Farley. Bob was a 1945 graduate of Freedom High School, following which he served in the U.S. Army during World War II under McArthur. A lifetime Garrettsville resident, Bob was the owner-operator of Farley- Ellerhorst Insurance from 1979 until retiring in 1995. He served on the Garrettsville Village Council, and was a very active member of the Chamber of Commerce. He was a member of the Garrettsville United Methodist Church, and Garrettsville Masonic Lodge No. 246 F.& A.M. where he was Master from 1958-1959. While Bob enjoyed traveling, memories of him attending school functions of his daughters and grandchildren will forever be cherished. On April 3, 1948, he married his beloved wife Jean (Russell) Farley who survives at their home.
