Vivian J. Horvath, 77 years of age, passed away Saturday December 8, 2018 at her residence. Born in Cleveland, Ohio on March 5, 1941, she was the daughter of the late Charles and Joan (Rybka) Pallo. A 1959 graduate of Crestwood High School, she was a former longtime Mantua area resident, living in Rootstown the past 15 years. Vivian had been employed as a bus driver for the Crestwood School System for 10 years, and was the owner-operator of HanCraft from 1985-1990. Over the years, Vivian was active as a volunteer including at the St. Joseph's Ox Roast, and for the Portage County Board of Elections as a poll worker. She enjoyed sewing, was well known for her love of playing bingo, and was a true animal lover to many of God's creatures. Vivian will always be remembered as a lady with a huge heart for everyone, and while her passing leaves a void in the hearts of family and friends, the memories that she created will forever be cherished. On June 20, 1959, she married her beloved husband William A. Horvath, Jr, who survives at their home.
