Steven R. Wegener, 64 years of age, passed away Thursday August 30, 2018 at his residence. Born in East St. Louis, Illinois on November 24, 1953, he was the son of the late Richard H. and Camille (Shank) Wegener. Formerly a longtime Bainbridge Township resident, he was a 1973 graduate of Kenston High School. Mr. Wegener was a resident of Streetsboro the past 30 years. He was a U.S. Navy Veteran. Employed at Rotek in Aurora , he retired in 2015 after 28 years of service.
