Opal L. Miner, 89 years of age, passed away Monday July 23, 2018 at Aurora, Ohio. Born in Ravenna, Ohio on November 30, 1928, she was the daughter of the late Leo J. and Lois D. (Rogers) Gless. Mrs. Miner was a lifetime resident of the Mantua area, and a graduate of Shalersville High School. She was the bookkeeper and ran the family farm with her husband John Thomas Miner until retirement.
