SHALERSVILLE / MANTUA Hazel M. (Mickee) Hawkins, 85 years of age, passed away peacefully on Friday October 27, 2017, at the home of her daughter Monica Belrose.

Mickee was born in Burnsville, West Virginia on September 21, 1932, the daughter of the late Wesley and Janie (Ocheltree) Brown. She was a resident of the Shalersville area since 1960.
