## **Theresa Klemm**

**H**IRAM Theresa Klemm, 96 years of age, passed away Saturday September 9, 2017 in Troy Township, Ohio.

Born in Serbia on November 10, 1920, she was the daughter of the late Christian and Apollonia (Basler) Wolfli. A homemaker, Mrs. Klemm had been a resident of the Hiram area since 1965. She was a longtime member of St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Garrettsville where she was active with the Alter & Rosary Society.

While she enjoyed sewing, gardening and baking, the times she spent watching her grandchildren brought many special moments into her life.

On November 21, 1939, she married Josef Klemm who preceded her in death in 1990. Also preceding her was one daughter Notburga Kohler in 2005.

Survivors include her children Helmuth (Roswitha ) Klemm of St. Peters, Missouri, Stefan Klemm of St. Paul, Minnesota, Ingeborg (Gary) Carpenter of Powell, Ohio and Adelheid (Robert) Simsa of Hiram, Ohio.
