GARRETTSVILLE Opaline L. Prince Dean. 86 years of age, passed away Friday May 19, 2017 at her residence with her loving family by her side.

Born in Falls Mills, West Virginia on March 28, 1931, she was the daughter of the late Gordon and Retha (Bowyer) Dyer. She had been a resident of the Garrettsville-Windham area the past 56 years, and was a member of the Windham Bible Church.

Mrs. Dean had been employed at Hiram College for over 24 years where she served as catering manager. She will always be remembered as a "Lady Who Loved Life", and enjoyed gardening, going to auctions, bowling, playing cards, traveling to casinos, and was an avid Cleveland Cavalier fan, LeBron James being her man.
