GARRETTSVILLE Robert G. Fellenstein, Sr., 93 years of age, passed away Sunday April 9, 2017 at his residence.

Born in Cleveland, Ohio on December 27, 1923, he was the son of the late Richard and Mae (Klein) Fellenstein. Bob had been a resident of the Garrettsville area the past 20 years, formerly being a longtime Aurora resident where he had been a graduate of Aurora High School class of 1942.

During World War II, he proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy aboard the U.S.S. Blue. Bob had been employed as an electrician at Chrysler Twinsburg from 1959, until he retired in 1989. An avid golfer, he enjoyed all sports, especially supportive of Cleveland Sports Teams, and in addition participated in several bowling leagues where his skills were seen in bowling his 300 game.
