**C**UYAHOGA FALLS Andrew M. Walker, 88 years of age, passed away Tuesday October 4, 2016 at his residence in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio.

Born in Bellaire, Ohio on May 11, 1928, he was the son of the late George and Mary (Kish) Walker. A resident of Cuyahoga Falls the past 6 years, Mr. Walker formerly was a longtime Cleveland resident, and had been employed at AJAX Window Cleaning Company in Cleveland from where he retired.

During World War II he honorably served his country in the U.S. Army. He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles in Chagrin Falls, and enjoyed hunting and fishing as pastimes.

Preceding him in death was his wife Marge Walker in 2008, and 2 sisters. Survivors include his children Scott (Melissa) Walker of Little Elm, Texas, Michael (Jane) Walker and Christopher Walker both of Akron, Robert (Lyndia) Walker of Oklahoma, Andrea (Steve) Hazel of Hiram, and Adena (Steve) Starcher and Cynthia (Don) Martin both of Cuyahoga Falls, 16 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren.
