## David Lee Stevens

SEP 11, 1936 - AUG 30, 2016

**S**HALERSVILLE David L. Stevens, 79 years of age, passed away Tuesday August 30, 2016 at Portage Medical Center-UH in Ravenna, Ohio. Born in Johnstown, Pennsylvania on September 11, 1936, he was the son of the late Charles and Eileen (McClain) Stevens. A resident of the Shalersville area the past 37 years, Mr. Stevens had been employed at Chrysler Parts Depot in Solon from where he retired in 1996. During the Korean Conflict he served his country in the U.S. Army. An avid Steelers and Dallas Cowboys fan, he also enjoyed fishing, golfing and hunting. Mr. Stevens was a talented guitar player, formerly playing with his brother-in-law's band, enjoyed playing the organ, and found pleasure singing for his grandchildren, creating special memories for them and all of his family.
