Mrs. Atwood was God's Gift to Us on July 27, 1937 in Coshocton, Ohio the daughter of the late Harry and Elsie (Benson) Hook. A homemaker, Mrs. Atwood had been a Mantua area resident the past 53 years, and was a longtime member of the Blackhorse Baptist Church. Mom enjoyed cooking, gardening and listening to jazz music.
