RAVENNA-SHALERSVILLE William S. Stewart, 89 years of age, passed away Tuesday April 5, 2016 in Ravenna, Ohio.

Born April 3, 1927 in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late Ralph and Thelma (Evans) Stewart. Mr. Stewart was a longtime resident of the Ravenna and Shalersville areas, and had been a member of Immaculate Conception Church in Ravenna.
