GARRETTSVILLE Sharon Ann Farley, 64 years of age, passed away Saturday September 26, 2015 at the home of her sister Denise Ellerhorst with her loving family by her side. Sharon was born in Ravenna, Ohio on February 8, 1951, the daughter of Robert J. and Jean (Russell) Farley. Sharon grew up in Garrettsville, and then graduated from Lakeview High School in Cortland in 1969. A 1975 graduate from Kent State University with a degree in Deaf Education, she then earned her Master's in Education at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. From 1975-1987, she taught in the New Orleans Public Schools, following which she taught at the Governor Morehead School For The Blind in Raleigh, North Carolina, retiring in 2013. Sharon devoted much of her life to giving to others which included as a volunteer at the Dorcas Thrift Store and at numerous homeless shelters, often assisting to make Thanksgiving a day that the less fortunate could be cared for by her presence. She held membership in the Lion's Club of Raleigh, North Carolina following in the goals which Lion's International are known to embrace. Sharon had many likes that included her cooking skills and entertaining of family and friends, her special times spent at the beaches and crabbing, but the love of her family and the memories created with times they shared together will forever be the most cherished of her 64 years.
