MANTUA William David Alger, 86 years of age, passed away Saturday November 23, 2013 in Aurora, Ohio. His smile, his love of chocolate, and the fact that Bill liked everyone and everyone liked him, will be cherished memories for family and friends. Following his military service, Bill came home and married Glenna (Heckman) Alger, whose passing took place in 1990 after 42 years of marriage.
