Born in Warren, Ohio on February 24, 1970, he was the son of Earl and Ruth (Sloan) Pelsue. Charlie was a lifetime Garrettsville area resident, and a 1988 graduate of James A. Garfield High School. Following graduation, he attended Northwestern University for 2 years. Charlie had formerly been employed at Solon Grinding and Anderson International in Cleveland, the past 2 years working as a maintenance repairman at Reliable Contracting in Chagrin Falls. He was a member of the United Methodist Church of Garrettsville. A farmer at heart, he was a lifetime farmer on the family farm in Nelson Township. Charlie was preceded in death by his father Earl "Buck" Pelsue in 1978, his brothers Mack Pelsue in 1998, Steven Rezabek in 2006 and Burton Pelsue in 2009.
