HIRAM James J. Pochedly, 84 years of age, passed away Monday December 24, 2012 at his residence. Born on June 2, 1928 in Freedom Township, Ohio, he was the son of the late Martin R. and Mary C. (Marek) Pochedly. A lifetime area resident, Mr. Pochedly was the founder and owner-operator of Pochedly Farms in Hiram since 1955.
