Glenn was God's Gift to Us on July 14, 1927 in Cleveland, Ohio, the son of the late Frank and Emma (Blaha) Moravec. A graduate of East High School, he then served his country proudly during World War II in the United States Navy. For 38 years, he was employed as a lineman for the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company. A resident of the Mantua area the past 37 years, Mr. Moravec attended Streetsboro Church of God where he loved his church and the members he grew to know. Glenn held memberships in the Aurora V.F.W. and W.K. Ricksecker Lodge No. 606 F.&A.M. of Aurora. Golfing and feeding the birds were special enjoyments he did in his spare time. On September 6, 1975, he married Mary (Mellott) Moravec who survives at their home. Also surviving are his children Jeffrey Moravec of Mantua, Jon Moravec of Ravenna, Jill (Don) Skonieczny of Aurora and JoAnn (Joe) Kist of Akron, 5 grandchildren, 4 great-grandchildren and his 4-legged child Jo Jo.
