MANTUA Sally Brugmann, 101 years young, passed away Sunday July 22, 2012 at her residence surrounded by her loving family. A lifetime resident of the Streetsboro and Mantua areas, Mrs. Brugmann started with her late husband Oscar Brugmann, Sr., Oscar Brugmann Sand & Gravel, Inc. in 1929, which remains their family business today. Sally enjoyed crocheting, knitting, cake decorating, gardening and was a champion checker player. As the Matriarch of the Brugmann Family, her warm smile and loving manner will not only be missed, but will always be a cherished memory for her family. A lady in the true sense, Sally shared her life in community involvements, especially holding a special feeling for the 4 C's Food Drive. An amazing person, she remained alert and active for 101 plus years right up until the time of her passing. She was a longtime member of the Mantua Center Christian Church and the Mantua Garden Club.
