GARRETTSVILLE Thomas F. Goff, 68 years of age, passed away Sunday November 6, 2011 at his residence. Born on August 18, 1943 in Chardon, Ohio, he was the son of the late Horace and Greta (Thompson) Goff. A longtime resident of Burton, he was a Garrettsville-Freedom Township area resident the past 40 years. A U.S. Army Veteran of the Viet Nam Era, he was a member of the Windham American Legion Post No. 0674, also holding memberships in the Fraternal Order of Eagles No. 3332 in Garrettsville and Teamsters Local No. 407. Mr. Goff formerly was employed at CFL Freight Lines in Cleveland and Blair Cartage in Ravenna, following which he worked for 8 years at the Save-4 in Shalersville until his retirement.
