MANTUA Joseph "Joe" Koval, 80 years of age, passed away Tuesday October 18, 2011 at his residence. Joe was born on August 1, 1931 in Fairpoint, Ohio the son of the late Joseph and Mary (Janicki) Koval. A resident of the Mantua-Shalersville areas since 1960, Joe was the President-Owner of Custom Plastic Extrusions, Inc. in Ravenna which he opened in 1966, retiring then in 1999. He was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Mantua and the Mantua Knights of Columbus. He was a veteran of the Korean Conflict proudly serving his country in the U.S. Marine Corps. Joe enjoyed fishing which included charter fishing with family and friends, hunting, the outdoors and doing yard work at his home, working on his cars and those very special times spent with all of his family. On May 17, 1958, he married Kathleen "Katie" (Mahoney) Koval who survives at their home.
