Ila was God's Gift to Us on August 24, 1921 at the Turner Family Farm in Mantua Township, where her passing also took place. She was the daughter of the late William F. and Ruby L. (Boone) Turner. A homemaker, Ila married Clarence Powell on September 11, 1944 and together they operated Powell's Sunoco Service Station in Doe Run, West Virginia. In 1997, she returned to the Mantua area where she was an active member of the Mantua Center Ladies Cemetery Association, the Mantua Historical Association and Portage Faith United Methodist Church. Ila enjoyed all sports and remained an avid Cleveland Browns fan. She will always be remembered for her patriotic spirit and looked forward each year to celebrating the 4th. of July.
