STREETSBORO Olive H. Willett, 94 years of age, passed away Friday September 24, 2010 at her residence in Streetsboro. Born on April 10, 1916 in New Springfield, Ohio, Mrs. Willett was the daughter of the late Lee and Henrietta (Geiger) Seidner. A homemaker, she was a resident of the Austintown area for 50 years, moving to the Streetsboro-Mantua areas in 2001. Mrs. Willett was employed at Stambaugh-Thompson as head of the painting department, retiring in 1981. She was a longtime member of Brownlee Presbyterian Church and enjoyed gardening as a pastime.
