Doris was a Cleveland Press motor route carrier for many years and also drove school bus for the Kenston School District. An accomplished seamstress herself, as a 4-H leader in the Mantua area, she taught many young ladies to sew. A lady who knew the meaning of hard work, she had a strong, but gentle spirit, and would always have the final say! Doris loved and was devoted to her family, and took great pride in sharing her fondness of playing cards with many of her grandchildren, which gave her special moments of bonding with them and providing lasting memories of her wit. Doris was currently a member of the American Legion Auxiliary # 193 in Mantua. On November 3, 1945, she married Eugene "Jack" Fejedelem who survives at their residence. Also surviving are her children Carol (Ray) Corbett, Glenn (Mary) Fejedelem and Dale (Rosalie) Fejedelem all of Mantua and Jeanne Deuley of Shalersville; sisters Julia "Peggy" Winchell of Mantua and Wilma Brown of Auburn Township, as well as 13 grandchildren and 2 great-grandsons.
