**H**ilda D. Berta 85 years of age, a lifetime Hiram area resident, passed away Thursday January 22, 2009 at Copeland Oaks in Sebring, Ohio.

Mrs. Berta was born January 10, 1924 in Streetsboro, Ohio the daughter of the late Harry C. and Florence (Elliman) Dade. Mrs. Berta was employed by the Cleveland Public Library after which she worked for the Portage County Library in Hiram for 20 years retiring in 1984.
