# Lima Jean Stalnaker

JUN 18, 1933 - DEC 22, 2023

**L**ima Jean (Johnston) Stalnaker, 90 years of age, passed away Friday, December 22, 2023, at University Hospital in Ravenna, Ohio. Born in Hunting Ground, West Virginia on June 18, 1933, she was the daughter of the late William Guy and Shirley Arlene (Sponaugle) Johnston. On August 14th, 1950, she married Commodore Perry Stalnaker, Jr. who preceded her in death in 2013.

A resident of the Hiram area since 1975, Mrs. Stalnaker was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, and homemaker. She was a member of the Hiram Ward of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. She served her church in several ways including conducting tours through The Historic John Johnson Home in Hiram Ohio along with speaking and teaching classes in her church. 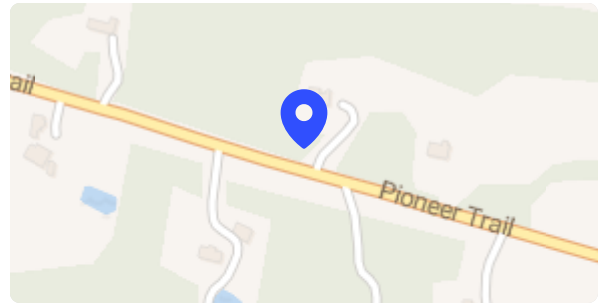

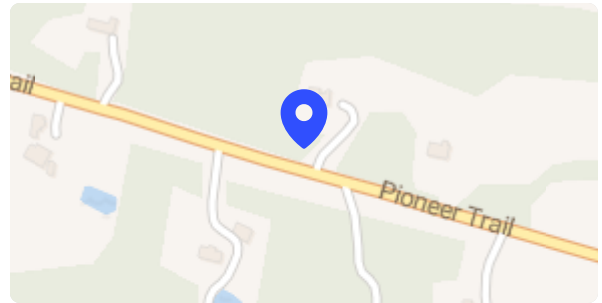

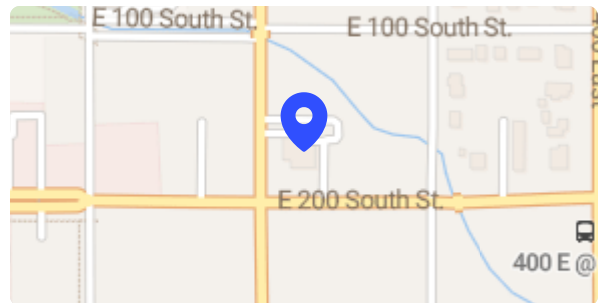
