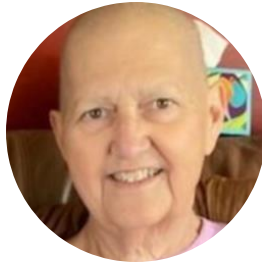

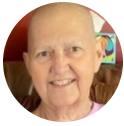
AUG 19, 1959 - MAY 27, 2024

Denise Ann Cuper (Behn), age 64 of Aurora, passed away Monday, May 27, 2024. Denise was born on August 19, 1959 in Oneida County, WI to Albert L. and Mary A. (Alhborn) Behn (both deceased). She was a 1977 graduate of Aurora High School and on September 10, 1977 she married her husband of 46 years, Michael S. Cuper Jr. Denise worked as a long time bus driver for Kenston School District.
