Marcia A. Ames (nee Sweet), age 83 of Mantua Township, passed away Weds., Oct 2, 2024 at Ahuja Medical Center in Beachwood, after a short battle with cancer. Born March 28, 1941 in Mantua, Ohio, she was the daughter of the late Wilbur and Mary (McCann) Sweet. Marcia was a 1960 graduate of Crestwood High School and on June 9, 1962, she married the love of her life, Richard Ames, who preceded her in death in 1990.

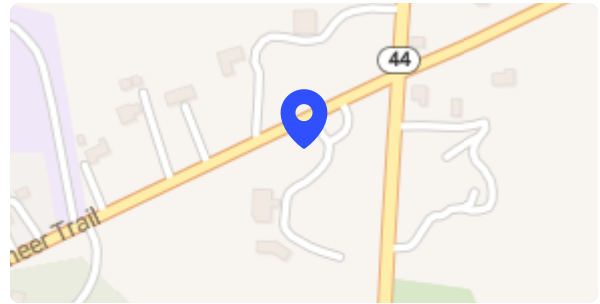

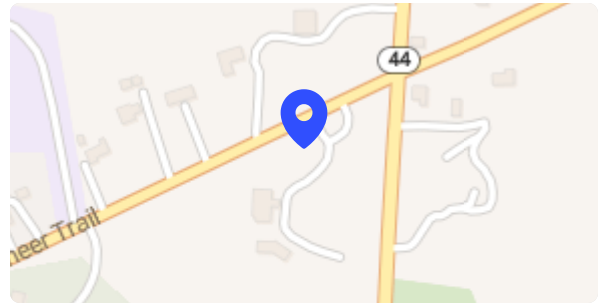

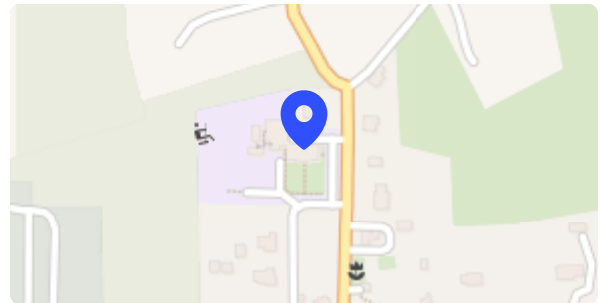
