In lieu of flowers, donations may be made in her memory to a charity of your choice.

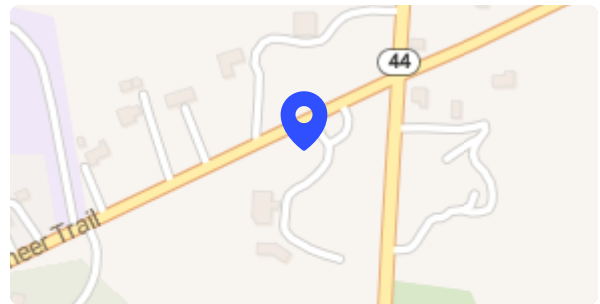

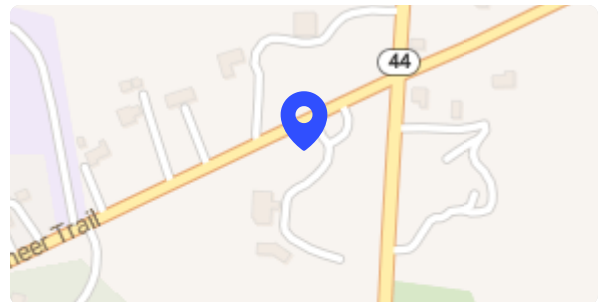

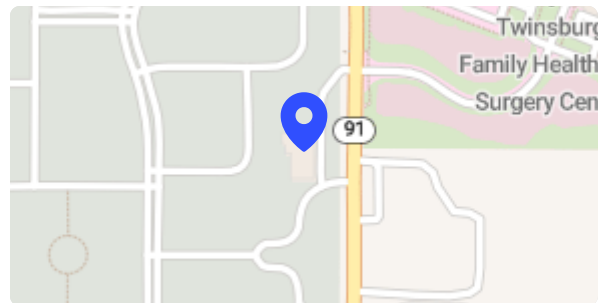
